Synopsis

It's 1965, and capital punishment has just been abolished in the UK.

In a dingy pub in the north of England, the landlord, Harry, who until recently was known as 'the second-best hangman in Britain', holds court.

Surrounded by a motley crew of sycophants and hangers-on, he relishes the celebrity his profession has brought him.

His wife, Alice, works behind the bar; neither seems to notice that their anxious, awkward teenage daughter, Shirley, is ripe for exploitation.

The arrival of Mooney, a mysterious stranger from London creates an atmosphere toxic with suspicion, and when Harry's arch-rival turns up, the clash of egos is brutal.

Harry Wade 50-60 years old

The central character who runs the pub. Harry is a commanding presence, exuding the charisma of a local celebrity and former chief hangman. A bluff, blunt, and proud Northerner, he navigates the complexities of his past with turns of aggression, ultimately revealing his deep-seated insecurities

*northern accent required

Peter Mooney 20-30 years old

Charismatic, confident, mysterious with an odd sense of humour. Mooney, possesses a magnetic charm and a peculiar sense of humour that keeps others intrigued/confused. Mooney is a Londoner with a unique vibe that sets him apart.

*London accent required

Syd Armfield 30-60 years old

Serves as Harry's assistant, revealing a crafty nature beneath his seemingly inept exterior. He stutters under stress but manages to be more cunning than expected. The resentful underdog

*northern accent required

Inspector Fry 40 - 60s years old

Plain clothes police inspector, intimidating yet weak deep down. He turns a blind eye while drinking on duty. Despite his loner status, a weakness lurks beneath the surface.

Bill 30 - 70s years old

One of Harry's biggest admirers. A racist alcoholic who shows some unexpected tenderness. His character adds depth to the dynamics of the pub.

Charlie 30 -70's years old

The mediator between others, engaging by laughingly repeating what others say, he contributes to the camaraderie of his fellow drinkers

*northern accent required

Arthur 30 - 70's years old

Regular at the bar. With a touch of deafness and slowness, he provides comic relief by laughing at jokes that others have moved on from. His dry, deadpan, and tactless demeanour adds a unique flavour.

Derek Clegg 18 - 35 years old

Clegg is an inexperienced cub reporter. Out of his depth, he is teased for his baby-face but gradually discovers his journalistic side.

Alice Wade 40 - 60 years old

The landlady, a proud woman running the pub with her husband, Harry. A long suffering wife, Alice is resilient and gives as good as she gets. Finds it challenging being the mother of a teenager

*northern accent required

Shirley Wade 15 years old

Shirley, is the teenage daughter of the publicans. Despite being described as plain and mopey, she possesses a quiet, dry sense of humour and a shy demeanour. The role requires an actor 16+ who can convincingly portray the character's age.

James Hennessy 20 - 30 years old

Cheeky, emotional. Facing imminent hanging, he vehemently protests his innocence and must be physically restrained. The role demands emotional depth and versatility Only appears in first scene

Albert Pierrepoint 50-70 year old

Appears only in the final scene. Albert Pierrepoint, is a high-status, smartly dressed, and quick-witted character. Charismatic and dominating, he becomes Harry's nemesis, taking command in the most inopportune moment.

Rehearsals
